The ACSA Board of Directors has passed an amendment to the Bylaws to change the allowed number of Board Members from 5 to 8.

This change will let the ACSA create four regions with 2 Board Members in each region.

The objective, as stated in the Bylaws, is to further promote the interests of Cormo sheep breeders. We feel that is advantageous to display and advertise the Cormo Wool and Cormo Sheep.

The election of officers and board members is required every two years. The board members, in each region, are to be staggered so that only one is elected each year.
